The HD Chair takes its inspiration from the rich history of machinist chairs.

Made from plywood the seat and back are mounted onto rubber, allowing the chair to respond and self adjust to the movements of the body whilst providing excellent support and comfort. Ideal for office or home use the HD chair come with a stackable base.

#### Base

Cast aluminium or powder coat finish, gaslift mechanism and nylon castors

#### <u>Seat</u>

Moulded foam over a tubular steel frame with ply seat insert

# Warranty

- Fabric
- Vacuum fabric regularily.
- Professionally dry clean fabric or wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Leather
- Dust frequently with a clean, dry cloth
- Wipe clean with a damp, slightly soapy cloth
- Metal and Wood
- Wipe clean with a damp, Slightly soapy cloth

#### Maintenance

- Do not use a cleaning agent that contains an abrasive, ammonia, bleach, spirit or other aggressive constituent, including without limitation D10 sanitiser.
- Remove stains immediately after spillage with a wet cloth (such as ink, coffee, tea, red wine).
- Do not use wax as a build up can occur and ruin the wood finish.

The HD Chair carries a ten years warranty. For further details please refer to our Terms and Conditions.

#### Design

We imbed sustainability from the beginning of the design process. At VG&P we believe a product that does not break, does not have to be replaced and a product that can be repaired does not have to be recycled. Materials are precious resources, and our aim is to respect, celebrate and use them responsibly. Our mantra is 'sustainability through longevity'. We are members of FISP (Furniture Industry Sustainability Programme) and are FSC™ certified (FSC™-C158750)

We take a hands-on approach, working closely with our suppliers to inform our design and achieve the best results. The quality of our products comes first, we never compromise on materials or manufacturing. Our products are built to last and are manufactured responsibly in the UK and Europe by a carefully selected network of material suppliers and fabricators.

The Very Good & Proper by-line is 'Measure twice, cut once' – sage advice that captures the commitment to quality, sense of playfulness and attention to detail expressed in our products.

#### Materials

Our aim is to create products that use materials to their advantage and in the most resourceful way while always keeping an eye on ways to improve our designs to limit waste.

We are FSC certified and can offer a selection of our products with chain of custody certification. All timber purchased for our workshop is FSC certified and we are currently working on a system to pass this claim on to our customers

#### Production

We have a workshop in London where we manufacture a vast amount of our products and source components from the UK or Europe to be assembled in our London based warehouse. We use a combination of hand-building techniques and modern digital technology to produce timelessly designed and durable furniture to a very high quality.

#### Packaging and Distribution

As part of one of our improvement initiatives, we have been working hard on removing plastics from our packaging and replacing them with more sustainably sourced paper based packaging. We have in the last year managed to cut our plastic use by around 50%.

We use a firm of electric vehicles for our local London based deliveries and where feasible work with our clients to retrieve and reuse packing materials.

#### Life of Product

Our products are designed in such a way that allows us in most cases to repair or replace any damaged component. This means that we are able to extend the life of our products, delaying the time that any non-recyclable part will go to land-fill. We encourage customers to get in touch with us if they have a faulty or damaged part to arrange a replacement.
